



Section Two: Identification Scenarios. Read each of the scenarios below. For each scenario, say whether the character relies on a "Hot" or "Cool" system of thinking, and use specific evidence to back up your point.

1. Hermione has an important Chemistry exam tomorrow that's worth 50% of her grade for the semester. If she does poorly on this Chemistry exam, she might not pass the class. However, the Winter Ball is happening tonight, and Hermione would really like to spend some time hanging out with friends. After carefully weighing her options, Hermione decides to stay in the library and study for the sake of her education. She can hang out with Ron and Harry another time.

2. Daenerys has wanted to be queen of the Seven Lands since she was a young girl. When she finally arrives in the Seven Lands, Daenerys burns the capital city out of sudden rage and a desire to show off her power, even though all the people have already surrendered. She didn't give herself the time to think about how there would be no land left to rule if she burned everything and that any people that survived would likely hate her.

3. Katniss' family completely relies on her to provide food for them: Katniss is the only one who knows how to hunt game in the forest and trade it for other goods in the market. When Prim is picked to participate in the Starvation Struggles, an annual battle to the death, Katniss is overcome with anger and sadness. In a split second, Katniss yells that she volunteers to take Prim's place in the Starvation Struggles, even though Katniss would be more helpful to her family in the long run if she just stayed home and let Prim go.
