



Divestment: Worksheet

Short Answer: Individually answer the following questions fully and succinctly.

1. What is an endowment?
2. What are three reasons for divesting?
3. List the different divestment movements mentioned in the video.

Token Time Activity: The instructor should divide the class into groups of 3-4 students. Each group signifies its own company. Then allot each company a varying number of tokens, signifying money. For example, some companies may have 3 tokens, while others have 5 or 6. Give students five minutes to make their choices, and then regroup as a class.

The goal of the game is to have the most money (tokens) and the greatest health. To do this, your company has to pick one of the following investment options:

- Fossil Fuel Industry: Your money doubles, but you must roll the Health Die. If the die lands on an even number, two of your team members will become "sick."
- Clean Energy: Your money increases by 50%. You do not have to roll the Health Die.
- No Investment: Your money stays the same, and you do not have to roll the Health Die.

Activity Debrief: Answer the following questions.

1. Which option did your group choose? Why?
2. What was the most frequently chosen option? Why do you think it was so popular?
