Make sure:
The first letter in your title is capitalized
The title tells the reader the topic you are writing about
The title is not general (it should be unique to what you have to say)
Introduction: A short paragraph giving background information on the event/topic (2-3
sentences)
Your thesis statement (one sentence that tells the reader what your argument is)
Paragraph 1: One reason why your argument is correct. Use sources and facts to support you
ideas, not just your opinions. (3-4 sentences)

Paragraph 2: Another reason why your argument is correct. Use sources and facts to support
our ideas, not just your opinions. (3-4 sentences)
aragraph 3: What would someone who disagrees with you say about this topic? Why are they
correct? Use facts and sources to support you, not just opinions. (4-5 sentences).
onclusion: A final point that will make your reader remember your argument (2 sentences)
